

ULTRA ADVANCED UPPER EXTREMITY COURSE

Course Description:

This 5-day NEURO-IFRAH® Organization Approved Ultra Advanced course is designed for therapists who have completed an advanced upper extremity course or a Neuro-Dynamic Therapy or NEURO-IFRAH® Certification course originated by Waleed Al-Oboudi. Information presented in this course expands on and exceeds advanced concepts to increase the specialized clinician's handling, knowledge and problem solving skills.

The emphasis is placed on multiple strategies to develop all characteristics of upper extremity function and carry over at various levels of recovery.

Numerous unmatched lab will focus on increasing the experienced clinician's options in handling and increasing patient's responses to management.

As in advanced courses, highly effective, holistic and inclusive strategies will be utilized in accessing the patients in a variety of ways with ongoing attention to overall whole body and system functional coordination.

The format will include lectures, practice labs, problem solving, patient demonstration by the instructor and actual patient management by the participants. All information will be supported by handouts and audio visual materials.

Course Objectives

Upon completion of the course participants will be able to:

1. Identify a minimum of 3 strategies to increase upper extremity use for support, manipulation, balance, expression, as a tool, emotional release, comfort, containment, protection and propulsion in various conditions of observation.
2. Identify individualized strategies to effectively increase mobility throughout the upper extremity and related structures throughout the body.
3. Differentiate between normal and abnormal upper extremity function, and biomechanical alignment in various conditions of observation
4. Develop protocols to enhance patient follow through and team reinforcement throughout the continuum of care.
5. Apply handling techniques effectively to restore upper extremity function an actual patient with hemiplegia from a stroke or brain injury.

ULTRA ADVANCED HAND FUNCTION/ FINE MOTOR CONTROL COURSE

Course Description:

This 5-day NEURO-IFRAH® Organization Approved Course Ultra-Advance Course is specifically designed for occupational therapists who specialize in treatment of adults with hemiplegia from a stroke or brain injury. The emphasis of this course is on restoring all characteristics of hand function with emphasis on the re-acquisition of manipulation in coordination with the whole body and other systems. This course builds on the unique and highly effective strategies introduced in the Advanced Hand Function/Fine Motor Control course. Participants applying for this course must have completed an Advanced Hand Function/Fine Motor Control course, a Neuro-Dynamic Therapy Certification course, or a NEURO-IFRAH® Certification course originated by Waleed Al-Oboudi.

The format of this course will include lecture, lab, patient demonstration by the instructor and actual patient treatment by the participants.

Course Objectives

Upon completion of the course participants will be able to:

1. Identify three strategies to restore a minimum often characteristics of Hand Function.
2. Identify strategies to develop and maintain mobility throughout the hand, wrist and forearm.
3. Differentiate between normal and abnormal hand function and biomechanical alignment in various conditions and observation.
4. Develop protocols to enhance patient and team reinforcement and follow through throughout the continuum of care.
5. Apply handling techniques effectively to help restore hand function on an actual patient with hemiplegia from a stroke or brain injury.



ULTRA ADVANCED FUNCTION IN UPRIGHT POSTURES

Course Description:

This five day NEURO-IFRAH® Organization Approved Ultra Advanced Course is designed for physical and occupational therapist who specialize in the treatment of adults with hemiplegia from a stroke or brain injury. This course is the 4th in a series preceded by Walking for Life Intermediate Function in Upright Postures. As a pre-requisite to taking this course, participants must have completed Advanced Function in Upright Postures, a Neuro-Dynamic Therapy Certification course or a NEURO-IFRAH® Certification Course originated by Waleed Al-Oboudi. Other applicants may be accepted only with special permission by the instructor. This course is designed to build on and go beyond the highly effective strategies introduced in Advanced Function in Upright Posture course. This course will be focused on the development of refined and complex control required for effective resumption of higher level functional activities, i.e.: sports and work related activities requiring multi task processing and whole person/all system coordination. This course will cover the reacquisition of running, jumping, control with speed, force intensity, duration, sustaining performance and coordination. This course is specifically designed by Waleed A-Oboudi and promises to continue with the tradition of introducing concepts and strategies of management that are unmatched and surpass any concepts available in rehabilitation. The course format will include lecture, lab, patient demonstration by the instructor and patient management by the participants

Course Objectives:

Upon completion of this course, participants will be able to:

1. Identify the missing components of movement and otherwise interfering with a patient's ability to resume or assume desired level of functional activity or roles.
2. Develop management goals and plan that address the missing components interfering with patient's ability to resume or assume desired level of functional and activity or roles.
3. Implement a management plan that progresses a given patient step by step towards established management goals.
4. Develop a protocol for overall assessment and management of adult patients with hemiplegia who are interested in resuming a higher level of functional activity.

NEURO-DYNAMIC THERAPY ULTRA ADVANCED HANDLING INTENSIVE COURSE

Course Description:

This NEURO-IFRAH® Organization approved Course is designed for physical and occupational therapists who specialize in the treatment of adults with hemiplegia from a stroke or brain injury. This course is provided in two formats and lengths. The international three day format provided in France and Italy in 2004 is designed for clinicians who would like to combine travel with their educational experience and network on an international level. The two-Five day format is available for set up by appointment only with Waleed Al-Oboudi and will be held at the NEURO-IFRAH® Center in La Jolla, California.

The course format will include a list of challenges in management identified by the course participants, labs addressing each identified challenge with multiple management strategies, problem solving sessions by participants, audio visuals supporting concepts and strategies. Patient handling by participants included in courses provided in the United States of America.

1. Identify challenges to maximizing functional outcomes in various conditions of observation.
2. Identify management strategies to effectively address each challenge identified by participants.
3. Apply handling techniques to restore the missing components interfering with recovery.
